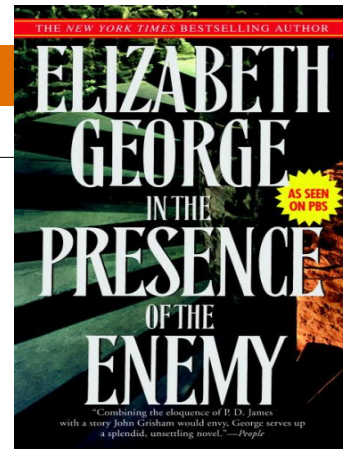

Who done it?

Solve your own mystery through letterboxing!

What is “letterboxing”?

Adapted from the British pastime of finding letterboxes on public trails, our version of letterboxing is the act of locating letterboxes in the library (similar to geocaching).

How do I find letterboxes?

The call number for each box will be posted on Facebook and wcls.org. Directions for letterboxes will be released weekly starting Saturday, January 14. The final letterbox location will be released the week prior to Elizabeth George's arrival.

Letterboxes will be shelved throughout the library, located near other works by Elizabeth George or works that relate to themes within *In the Presence of the Enemy*. Each letterbox contains an image. Collect all 5 image stickers to create a rebus (a visual puzzle) and then solve it.

What else do I need?

Ask staff for a “Who done it?” play card. Hint—you have to have read the book to solve the rebus!
